5. Please write a **one-page**, typed, personal statement, explaining your professional aspirations and accomplishments.
6. Students interested in majoring in Design or Production or Theatre Studies, should bring a design portfolio and other visual support materials to their interview.

V. DEADLINES

The on-campus audition dates for incoming freshmen in the 2009-10 academic year are:

Saturday, December 5, 2009
(Applications due November 30, 2009 – 5:00 PM)

Saturday, February 13, 2010
(Applications due February 8, 2010 – 5:00 PM)

You must have a scheduled appointment to audition and interview on one of these two dates. Once your completed application is received, you will be contacted to set up an audition time on the date you chose.

DEADLINE CALENDAR

It is highly recommended that you have taken both the SAT and ACT exams and have scores to report BEFORE applying for TCU theatre scholarships.

November 1, 2009: TCU Application - Early Action Deadline

If you wish to be reviewed early based on transcripts through your junior year, you must have your application postmarked by November 1. You must take the SAT or ACT no later than November. Nonbinding notification by January 1.

November 30, 2009: TCU BFA Theatre Auditions, & Scholarship Application Final Deadline for On-Campus Audition Date #1

If you wish to audition/interview for admission to the TCU BFA Theatre program, or be considered for the Nordan Fine Arts Awards and other TCU theatre scholarships and grants, your application must be received by this date. After your application has been received, you will be allowed to call and make an audition appointment for December 5, 2009.

December 5, 2009: TCU BFA Theatre Auditions & Scholarship Auditions On-Campus Audition Date #1

Students who have completed their applications to TCU and for TCU theatre scholarships, and who have scheduled an audition/interview appointment, will be auditioning on this date on campus at TCU.

December 15, 2009: TCU Academic Scholarship Consideration Deadline

If you wish to be considered for academic scholarships at TCU, you must have your application postmarked by December 15. You must take the SAT or ACT no later than January 1 for merit scholarship consideration. Admission notification will be in late February, with scholarship award notification in mid-March.

February 8, 2010: TCU BFA Theatre Auditions, & Scholarship Application Final Deadline for On-Campus Audition Date #2

If you wish to audition/interview for admission to the TCU BFA Theatre program, or be considered for the Nordan Fine Arts Awards and other TCU theatre scholarships and grants, your application must be received by this date. After your application has been received, you will be allowed to call and make an audition appointment for February 13, 2010.

February 13, 2010: TCU BFA Theatre Auditions & Scholarship Auditions On-Campus Audition Date #2

Students who have completed their applications to TCU and for TCU theatre scholarships, and who have scheduled an audition/interview appointment, will be auditioning on this date on campus at TCU.

February 15, 2010: TCU Application – Final Deadline

If you wish to include your fall semester/trimester grades, you must have your application postmarked by February 15. Notification by April 1. Applications received after February 15 will be considered on a space-available basis.
